

## **RULES AND MAINTENANCE OF CITY OF NILES, CEMETERY**

1. FRESH CUT FLOWERS IN A REGULATION BRONZE VASE ARE PERMITTED AT ALL TIMES
2. POTTED FLOWERS AND PLANTS ARE PERMITTED 5 DAYS BEFORE AND NO MORE THAN FIVE DAYS AFTER: EASTER, MOTHERS DAY, FATHERS DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, VETERANS DAY, BIRTHDAYS, ANNIVERSARY
3. WINTER WREATHS, BLANKLETS AND ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS ARE ONLY PERMITTED NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH MARCH 30<sup>TH</sup>
4. GLASS CONTAINERS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME
5. BORDERS AROUND MEMORIALS NOT PERMITTED
6. ONLY PEAT MOSS OR SIMILAR PRODUCTS MAY BE USED AROUND GRAVE, NO ROCK OR STONE
7. SPRING CLEAN UP OF THE CEMETERY BEGINS MARCH 30<sup>TH</sup> OF EACH YEAR. INDIVIDUALS, WHO WISH TO PICK UP WINTER WREATHS, ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS, ETC., MUST DO SO BEFORE THAT DATE. OTHERWISE, THEY WILL BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF BY THE CEMETERY EMPLOYEES.

**NOTE:** THE CITY OF NILES, AND ITS EMPLOYEES HAVE **“THE RIGHT OF WAY”** TO ALL CEMETERY PLOTS. ANY DAMAGE TO INDIVIDUALS LANDSCAPING DURING A BURIAL OR SESONAL MAINTENANCE ETC. IS STRICTLY THE PLOT OWNERS RESPONSIBILITY.

### **SPECIAL NOTICE**

IN REGARDS TO THE SAFETY OF ALL VISTORS AS WELL AS CEMETERY EMPLOYEES:

ANY PERSON, WHO HAS CHOSEN TO DECORATE WITH STONES, ROCKS ETC, ALONG WITH WOOD OR BRICK BORDERS, MUST HAVE THEM REMOVED BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2006 OR CEMETERY EMPLOYEES WILL REMOVE THEM.
