ORDINANCE NO. __ (Draft No. 21-10)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE NO. 375.03 REGARDING THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES, OFF-HIGHWAY MOTORCYCLES AND ALL PURPOSE VEHICLES, BY AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH (B) AND ADDING NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (C) TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
