Chief Holland commented on the Ohio Collaborative Law Enforcement Agency Certification awarded to the police department.

Law Director Dull announced he would be retiring in February 2017 as Law Director due to health issues.

Mr. Vivolo discussed how he was unaware of Draft No. 177-16. A long discussion was held with Councilwoman Marchese, Mr. Dull, Councilman Papalas, and Councilman Mientkiewicz.

Mr. Papalas: Announced he would not be running for re-election when his term is up. He felt he could do more for the city working at the Trumbull County Engineer's Office.

Mr. Steffey: Asked Chief Danielson to elaborate on the inspections of dilapidated buildings within the city.

Mr. Pezzano: Announced he would not being running re-election when his term is up. Advised the first roundtable in January 2017 would be to meet with the representatives from MVSD to update the city of pending projects.

It was moved by Steffey, seconded by McNaughton to go into executive session pursuant to ORC 121.22 to discuss compensation of public employees.

President Marino: Council is excused into executive session at 7:30 p.m.

President Marino: Council adjourned out of executive session at 8:15 p.m.
