AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENACTING AN ADDITIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE DOLLARS UPON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE DISTRICT OF REGISTRATION, WHICH IS THE CITY OF NILES, PURSUANT TO **SECTION 4504.17** OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD THEREOF, THE COLLECTION THEREOF, AND THE PURPOSE THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 4504.17 of the Ohio Revised Code allows the City of Niles to levy an annual motor vehicle license tax upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads or highways; and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be at the rate of five dollars per motor vehicle on all motor vehicles within the district of registration, which is the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be in addition to and regardless of, among other taxes, all motor vehicle license taxes already levied by the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be used for streets, highways and roads, and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes that the levy of such a tax is necessary and useful, and is in the best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to levy such a tax at the earliest possible time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: An annual tax is hereby levied on all motor vehicles, the district of registration of which is the City of Niles, at the rate of five dollars (\$5.00) per motor vehicle, pursuant to **Ohio Revised Code Section 4504.17**, subject to the exemption and reductions referred to in that Revised Code Section.

The tax levied by and within the Section shall be, and is in addition to, and regardless of the following:

- (1.) Any tax being levied by the City of Niles pursuant to Section 4504.06 or 4504.171 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,
- (2.) Any tax received by the City of Niles pursuant to Section 4504.04 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (3.) The tax levied by Sections 4503.02, 4503.07 and 4503.18 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (4.) The taxes at the rates specified in Sections 4503.04 and 4503.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be for the registration year commencing January 1, 2018, and such tax shall continue in effect during each and every registration year thereafter.

SECTION 3: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be paid to, and collected by, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio, or a Deputy Registrar, at the time of application for registration of a motor vehicle as provided for in Section 4530.10 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be, and is, for the purposes set forth in Section 4504.17 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All monies derived from the tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be credited to Fund No. 18, The Permissive Tax Fund, and shall be appropriated and used by the City solely for the purposes set forth previously in this Section.

SECTION 5: That the Clerk of this Council shall immediately cause this a summary of this Ordinance to be properly published. Upon publication the Clerk of this Council shall forward and deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio, 10 days following said publication.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENACTING AN ADDITIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE DOLLARS UPON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE DISTRICT OF REGISTRATION, WHICH IS THE CITY OF NILES, PURSUANT TO **SECTION 4504.171** OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD THEREOF, THE COLLECTION THEREOF, AND THE PURPOSE THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 4504.171 of the Ohio Revised Code allows the City of Niles to levy an annual motor vehicle license tax upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads or highways; and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be at the rate of five dollars per motor vehicle on all motor vehicles within the district of registration, which is the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be in addition to and regardless of, among other taxes, all motor vehicle license taxes already levied by the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be used for streets, highways and roads, and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes that the levy of such a tax is necessary and useful, and is in the best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to levy such a tax at the earliest possible time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: An annual tax is hereby levied on all motor vehicles, the district of registration of which is the City of Niles, at the rate of five dollars (\$5.00) per motor vehicle, pursuant to **Ohio Revised Code Section 4504.171**, subject to the exemption and reductions referred to in that Revised Code Section.

The tax levied by and within the Section shall be, and is in addition to, and regardless of the following:

- (1.) Any tax being levied by the City of Niles pursuant to Section 4504.06 or 4504.17 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,
- (2.) Any tax received by the City of Niles pursuant to Section 4504.04 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (3.) The tax levied by Sections 4503.02, 4503.07 and 4503.18 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (4.) The taxes at the rates specified in Sections 4503.04 and 4503.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be for the registration year commencing January 1, 2018, and such tax shall continue in effect during each and every registration year thereafter.

SECTION 3: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be paid to, and collected by, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio, or a Deputy Registrar, at the time of application for registration of a motor vehicle as provided for in Section 4530.10 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be, and is, for the purposes set forth in Section 4504.171 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All monies derived from the tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be credited to Fund No. 18, The Permissive Tax Fund, and shall be appropriated and used by the City solely for the purposes set forth previously in this Section.

SECTION 5: That the Clerk of this Council shall immediately cause this a summary of this Ordinance to be properly published. Upon publication the Clerk of this Council shall forward and deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio, 10 days following said publication, as such must be delivered before July 1, 2017.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
