SECTION 1: Council hereby approves the waiving of the permit and inspection fees collected by the Building Inspector for the new construction of the Niles Dragon Wagon and a new ticket booth at Bo Rein Stadium for the year 2017.

SECTION 2: Said permit and inspections fees as stated in Section 1301.07 and Section 1301.08 of the Niles Codified Ordinances shall pertain to City permit fees only. Any additional fees that the City is required to pay, such as but not limited to, electrical and plumbing inspections shall not be waived.

SECTION 3: The waiving of the permit and inspection fees collected by the Building Inspector shall not include the waiving of the required permit application process necessary for inspections to insure the safety of the structures.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare and for the reason that the construction must begin at the earliest possible date. As such, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH A REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX IN THE CITY OF NILES, OHIO AND DECALARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a Regional Council of Governments was created pursuant to Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code to foster cooperation between municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the Regional Council of Governments was primarily to establish a central collection facility, Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA) for the purpose of administering the income tax laws of the various participating member communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute, on behalf the City of Niles, a contract with a Regional Council of Governments for the administration and collection of the City of Niles's Income Tax, effective immediately.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to Section III, "Administrative Authority" of the Agreement, the Mayor shall appoint and Council shall approve one (1) representative to the Council of Governments and one (1) alternate who may act in place of the representative in the their absence.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, and to allow the City to move forward with transferring the collection of income tax to RITA at the earliest possible date. As such an emergency measure, this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENACTING AN ADDITIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE DOLLARS UPON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE DISTRICT OF REGISTRATION, WHICH IS THE CITY OF NILES, PURSUANT TO **SECTION 4504.17** OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD THEREOF, THE COLLECTION THEREOF, AND THE PURPOSE THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 4504.17 of the Ohio Revised Code allows the City of Niles to levy an annual motor vehicle license tax upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads or highways; and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be at the rate of five dollars per motor vehicle on all motor vehicles within the district of registration, which is the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be in addition to and regardless of, among other taxes, all motor vehicle license taxes already levied by the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be used for streets, highways and roads, and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes that the levy of such a tax is necessary and useful, and is in the best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to levy such a tax at the earliest possible time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: An annual tax is hereby levied on all motor vehicles, the district of registration of which is the City of Niles, at the rate of five dollars (\$5.00) per motor vehicle, pursuant to **Ohio Revised Code Section 4504.17**, subject to the exemption and reductions referred to in that Revised Code Section.

The tax levied by and within the Section shall be, and is in addition to, and regardless of the following:

- (1.) Any tax being levied by the City of Niles pursuant to Section 4504.06 or 4504.171 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,
- (2.) Any tax received by the City of Niles pursuant to Section 4504.04 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (3.) The tax levied by Sections 4503.02, 4503.07 and 4503.18 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
- (4.) The taxes at the rates specified in Sections 4503.04 and 4503.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be for the registration year commencing January 1, 2018, and such tax shall continue in effect during each and every registration year thereafter.

SECTION 3: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be paid to, and collected by, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio, or a Deputy Registrar, at the time of application for registration of a motor vehicle as provided for in Section 4530.10 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: The tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be, and is, for the purposes set forth in Section 4504.17 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All monies derived from the tax levied by and within Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be credited to Fund No. 18, The Permissive Tax Fund, and shall be appropriated and used by the City solely for the purposes set forth previously in this Section.

SECTION 5: That the Clerk of this Council shall immediately cause this a summary of this Ordinance to be properly published. Upon publication the Clerk of this Council shall forward and deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio, 10 days following said publication.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENACTING AN ADDITIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE DOLLARS UPON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE DISTRICT OF REGISTRATION, WHICH IS THE CITY OF NILES, PURSUANT TO **SECTION 4504.171** OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE PERIOD THEREOF, THE COLLECTION THEREOF, AND THE PURPOSE THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 4504.171 of the Ohio Revised Code allows the City of Niles to levy an annual motor vehicle license tax upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads or highways; and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be at the rate of five dollars per motor vehicle on all motor vehicles within the district of registration, which is the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be in addition to and regardless of, among other taxes, all motor vehicle license taxes already levied by the City of Niles, and,

WHEREAS, such tax shall be used for streets, highways and roads, and,
