MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS COUNCIL FOR AGENDA ITEMS

(Public comments began at 2:30 into recording)

George Kuriatnyk- Mr. Kuriatnyk has a question on draft no. 169-23 about adopting the comprehensive plan. He would like for someone to go into more detail about this and if there is no grant money to fund this, he would like to know where the money would come from.

Mayor Mientkiewicz explained that the comprehensive plan is a road map of the community's vision, thoughts, and ideas all put together on one paper. It addresses future land use, housing stock, infrastructure, and various other items that are pertinent to the future of Niles. For example, he thinks Mr. Kuriatnyk is referring to are components within the comprehensive plan about the redevelopment of properties downtown. Mayor Mientkiewicz stated that nothing in the comprehensive plan is concrete, and it shouldn't be. These plans are based on the current moment and are meant to be reviewed and changed periodically based off of the needs and wants of the community.

When referring to the grant dollars for the plan, most successful communities who are obtaining grant dollars do so because there is a plan in place. The objective was to put the thoughts, goals and ideas on paper so when we go to apply for grants all of the planning is in place in one document. This is what authorities are looking for when they go to award grants. Mr. Kuriatnyk said he understands that, but he wants to know where the money comes from if there are no grants. And if he were to make changes to the plan, he wants to know if that needs to come before council. Mr. Kuriatnyk specifically wanted to know about the grants for downtown. President Marino interjected to let Mr. Kuriatnyk know that his time has expired. He explained if there were no grants received, it would be up to council and the administration to determine how to fund those projects.
