WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC), administers financial assistance for the purpose of a water line replacement on Brown St/First St through the Appalachian Regional Commission grant program with the estimated contract price being Four Hundred Ten Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$410,150.00)), with local funding in the amount of \$205,150 and ARC funding in the amount of \$204,400.00;

WHEREAS, the City of Niles desires financial assistance under the Appalachian Regional Commission Grant Program.
