SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the (LPA/STATE) has identified the need for the described project:

Crack sealing on US-422 (Youngstown-Warren Rd) along the E Corp Limit to just south of Niles Vienna Road in the City of Niles.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by _____ City of Niles _____ of Trumbull County, (LPA)

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of way costs include eligible utility costs.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Niles and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason to begin the project at the earliest possible time in order to expedite the highway projects and promote highway safety. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

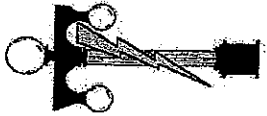

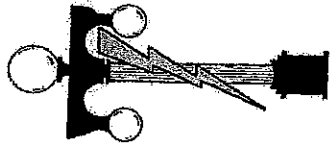

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 32-25 AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS REQUIRED BY APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION (ARC) FOR THE PARTNERSHIPS FOR OPPORTUNITY AND WORKFORCE AND ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION INITIATIVE (POWER) GRANT AND RATIFYING ALL ACTIONS TAKEN THUS FAR; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, funds are to be available through the Ohio Department of Development ARC POWER program dollars for the purpose of strengthening a variety of industries, including advanced manufacturing, entrepreneurship, healthcare, and workforce development, to bolster re-employment opportunities, create jobs in existing and new industries, and attract new sources of private investment in coal communities, and

WHEREAS, BEL will apply for the grant on the City's behalf, and

WHEREAS, said Grant award amount will be a maximum of Four Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$402,500.00); and the City of Niles will provide a maximum of One Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$172,500.00) match; and

WHEREAS, the ARC POWER grant is a reimbursable grant and requires awardees to incur costs first then submit to ARC/ODOD for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Development or Appalachian Regional Commission will notify grant awardees in Spring 2026. All awarded projects construction start date will be May 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Niles agrees to be responsible and comply with all Ohio Department of Development/Appalachian Regional Commission's Partnerships for Opportunity and Workforce and Economic Revitalization program requirements (state and federal award requirements); and

WHEREAS, the City of Niles will return to Niles City Council with more detailed information about the grant and partnerships if grant is awarded in the Spring of 2026. At that time the City will request City Council approve it to accept the grant and also go out to bid for a contractor for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Authorization is given to the Mayor to submit this application to the Appalachian Regional Commission's Partnerships for Opportunity and Workforce and Economic Revitalization Program in partnership with the Ohio Department of Development as the Basic Agency over ARC Construction projects.

SECTION 2: Council hereby authorizes and ratifies all actions taken by the Auditor to submit and execute all necessary documents necessary to effectuate the grant process, including but not limited to the financial commitment letter.

SECTION 3: This Amendment to Resolution No. 32-25 does not invalidate the terms of that Resolution as all other Sections remain in effect.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience

and welfare of the City of Niles and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is to apply for this funding within the next 30 days, and provided that it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
