## **Foundation Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Contractors must run line and make sure foundations are lined up with others in the row.
- 2. Contractors must complete the work during Cemetery hours of operations. Monday thru Friday 7a.m. to 3 p.m.
- 3. No hole is to remain empty or uncovered or foundation unoccupied without new stone for longer than two weeks. All holes are to be covered by frame and plywood.
- 4. All holes must meet depth requirements, no more than or less than 30 to 36 inches without the approval of the Cemetery Foreman/Superintendent.
- 5. Holes must be inspected before poured.
- 6. All contractors must use frames for foundations (no free pouring).
- 7. Any additional dirt, rocks etc. should be disposed properly in the cemetery's dump site.
- 8. All cement and materials must be cleaned up and put into dumpster, not trash cans.
- 9. Foundation locations and requests are to be given to the Cemetery Secretary at least two (2) weeks prior to work date as well as a \$75.00 foundation fee is due at this time. Foundation replacement and removal will have a \$25.00 filing fee.
- 10. All foundation work must be done by a registered licensed City of Niles Contractor with bond and insurance.
- 11. All Contractors while doing any type of work are responsible for any damages done while doing the foundation.
- 12. Any damage done to the grass or ruts and or indentations made will be the contractor's responsibility to fix.
- 13. When doing the work, vehicles are not permitted to be in the grass.
- 14. The City of Niles is not responsible for any lettering on the stone, only responsible for marking and inspecting the foundation.
- 15. Foundation location cost is \$75.00, each additional time the same lot needs marked again there will be an additional \$50.00 fee.
- 16. Footer location will not be done from May 1<sup>st</sup> thru May 31<sup>st</sup>. (All footer requests must be turned in prior to May 1st).
