Niles Set to Resurface Over 3 Million in City Streets

The City of Niles is slated for approximately 3.7 million dollars in local street resurfacing throughout the Spring and Summer months. This is a continued effort by the City to upgrade its aged infrastructure.

The local street resurfacing program will consist of the following streets:

Nancy (George to End), George (Vienna to End), Washington (Frederick to Cynthia), Blossom (Cassandra to Trumbull), Lincoln Way (Difford to End), Orchard (Hughes to Harris), Butterflied Circle (Lantern Lane to End), Hogarth (Robbins Ave. to North Rhodes), Hughes (North Crandon to Cedar), Sunny Estates (Meadowlark to Cul-de-Sac), Merlo Court (Sunny Estates to Cul-de-Sac), Pepperwood (Banyan to Cul-de-Sac), Clinton (Vienna Ave. to Hartzell), South Cleveland (Robbins Ave. to McKinley), Ann (Mason to Thomas), Henry (Summit to Belmont), Linden (Robbins Ave. to Vienna Ave.), Woodland (West Federal to End), Margaret (John to End), Wyoming (Fifth to Third), Nash (Fifth to End), Emma (Smith to Warren Ave.), Franklin (Water to Park), Central (Arlington to Franklin), Park (Main to State), Robbins Ave. (Cleveland to Vienna Ave.), Vienna Ave. (Robbins Ave. to Niles Vienna), Niles Vienna (Vienna Ave. to Youngstown-Warren Rd.), and Warren Ave. (Chestnut to Highland).

Funding sources include approximately \$1,600,000.00 worth of local funds and \$2,100,000.00 worth of state & federal grant funds.
